

III. ENERGY PRICES


- 11. The European Council addressed the recent spike in energy prices and considered the impact of the price rises on citizens and businesses, especially our vulnerable citizens and SMEs, striving to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The toolbox presented in the Commission Communication on tackling rising energy prices contains useful measures for both the short and the longer term.
- 13. The European Council invites:
 - the Commission to study the functioning of the gas and electricity markets, as well as the EU ETS market, with the help of the European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA). Subsequently, the Commission will assess whether certain trading behaviours require further regulatory action;
 - the Member States and the Commission to urgently make the best use of the toolbox to provide short-term relief to the most vulnerable consumers and to support European companies, taking into account the diversity and specificity of situations of Member States;
 - the Commission and the Council to swiftly consider medium and long-term measures that would contribute to energy at a price that is affordable for households and companies, increase the resilience of the EU's energy system and the internal energy market, provide security of supply and support the transition to climate neutrality, taking into account the diversity and specificity of situations of Member States; and
 - the European Investment Bank to look into how to speed up investment in the

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









Electricity retail











EU Emissions Trading Scheme







Gas storage








Gas storage in Europe






Pipeline flows and LNG terminal capacity





EU policy response



Targeted

Aid to households and companies

- Direct support for defined minimum consumption per household/inhabitant
- Support measures for industries to adapt



Temporary

Consumer protection & disconnection prevention

- Social payments can be financed with EU ETS revenues
- Safeguards or deferred payments

Enhanced cooperation and monitoring

- ACER: assess wholesale electricity market design
- ESMA: enhance monitoring of the carbon market
- Competition authorities monitor market

Tax exemptions or reductions

- Temporary exemptions or reduced rates
- Measures to finance renewable policies with sources other than the electricity bill

Energy poverty reporting and coordination

- Energy poverty and vulnerable consumers coordination group
- Energy poverty reporting in NECPs



Building a more resilient energy system

- Task ACER to study electricity market design
- Revise the security of supply regulation
- Support energy storage development
- Explore voluntary joint procurement of reserve gas stocks

Protecting end users and empowering energy communities

- Inform consumers
- Appoint suppliers of last resort
- Develop self-supply via individual renewable energy and energy community arrangements
- Wider market for PPA-s

Stepping up investments

in the green transition


- Member States' investment in renewables, energy efficiency, building renovations, trans-European networks; speed up permitting
- Help Member States make best use of EU budget and NextGenerationEU
- Council Recommendation on social and labour aspects of the green transition



- Avoid future price surges
- Further integrate the market
- Empower consumers
- Decarbonise the energy system

Reinforcing security of supply

- The Commission will:


 Propose regulatory framework for the gas and hydrogen market by December 2021.
 Consider revising the security of supply regulation to ensure more effective functioning arrangements.
- Adaptation to the energy transition and new risks (e.g. cybersecurity) Extended to renewable gases, future common cybersecurity rules in the gas sector.
- Making solidarity operational New default arrangements, compensation costs and ex-post control.
- More effective gas storage, enhanced European role of storage Part of mandatory risk assessment, agreed at regional level.
- Joint procurement of reserve stocks: enabling provisions
