CONCEPT

International Conference gathering representatives of the Parliaments of the EU Member States, Parliaments of European Union candidate countries, Parliaments of countries with special partnerships with the European Union and partner Parliaments of emerging democracies with a view to:

1. Commemorating the International Day of Parliamentarism stressing the historical roots of parliamentarism.

2. Highlight the key role of Parliaments in promoting democracy worldwide and the value of parliamentary institutions faced with the new challenges and threats to democracy (Russian invasion of Ukraine or the assault on parliamentary institutions, among others).

3. Enhance global parliamentary development and inter parliamentary cooperation.

4. Improve Parliaments' ability to address a series of global strategic challenges, focusing on the political involvement of women and young people.

5. Stress the position of Parliaments as core institutions of representative democracy, and hence, the importance of strengthening Parliaments as key aspect of the international strategy for the evolution of democracy.

6. On occasion of the International Day of Parliamentarism, on June 30, 2023, the deep roots of Spanish parliamentarism shall be stressed, particularly the role played in this sense by the *Cortes de León*, set up in 1188, which, according to the UNESCO represent the first documented example of parliamentarism in history.

Parliaments are one of the institutional pillars of representative democracy, together with elections and the Rule of Law. A strong and efficient Parliament contributes to









political stability, economic development and the citizens' quality of life. The EU Parliaments, and many others, are increasingly involved in parliamentary diplomacy and in providing technical support to the strengthening of Parliaments worldwide, acknowledging that support among counterparts is the most efficient way to share learnt lessons and transfer expertise to evolving Parliaments, which results in a stronger democracy.
